OUR RESPONSIBILITY:

PLEDGE ACCOUNTS

- For each meet a gymnast participates in, they must pay an entry fee.
- The Booster Club collects pledge payments from parents for all gymnast meet entry fees (including regionals and nationals, if applicable), team camp, event fees, and other miscellaneous fees, as the need arises.
- These fees are separate from and in addition to the tuition and registration fees that are paid directly to the gym.
- The Booster Club guarantees payments on behalf of all gymnasts and coordinates with the coaches at NMGC to enter all gymnasts in the applicable meets.
- Statements will be emailed to parents as per the payment schedule (separate document attached), or at any time upon request (email northmetrobc@gmail.com to request).
- Meets are entered at least 6 weeks in advance, often earlier. This is why meet fees are collected prior to the season starting.
- Your gymnast WILL NOT be entered into meets and will not be able to compete if your Booster Club fees are not paid and current. Please contact the Booster Club treasurer if you need to work out a separate payment schedule.
- The Booster Club will credit Pledge Accounts from participating individual fundraisers.

EVENTS - The Booster Club coordinates a December holiday party and an end-of-the-year banquet. The Booster Club may coordinate other team-building events throughout the season.

GENERAL FUND FUNDRAISING - The Booster Club fundraises throughout the competitive season for the benefit of all gymnasts for the following events:

- End-of-Year Banquet (includes location, catering, and entry for each gymnast). Each attending parent will pay additional fees for attendance.
- The Booster Club will cover a portion of a December holiday party and other team-building events with a shared cost to parents.
- Funds to offset team camp dues if funds are available. Available funds are determined by the Board each year. Parents will be notified in advance if the Booster Club is able to make this contribution.
- If any gymnast qualifies for regionals or nationals, the Board may be asked to assess whether the General Fund has the capability to cover those fees. If the Board determines there are insufficient funds, parents will cover the extra cost of those meet entry fees. These fees are not allocated in the estimated payment schedule provided at the beginning of the season.

- The Booster Club maintains a Fundraiser Calendar to give parents the opportunity to plan participation accordingly.
- If you are not interested in Individual Account fundraising for your gymnast, there is a "donate to opt out" option available. All families regardless of participation in individual account fundraising will receive information for General Fund fundraisers.
